2023 Covid Protocol

The Weld Re-9 school district has used guidance from Weld County Health and the Center for Disease Control to update our plan. Please read and execute the practices below to help us keep students safe and continue in-person instruction for the school year.

- Students and staff who are ill should stay at home. If students at school are determined to be ill by our nursing staff, they will be sent home until symptoms are gone.
- Wash your hands frequently with warm, soapy water for at least 20 seconds. Our teachers will provide sanitizer as well.
- If you need information on testing and/or vaccination locations, please contact your school office or the district office for assistance.
- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you sneeze or cough. Discard used tissues in the trash, then wash your hands.
- Avoid people who are sick with respiratory symptoms.
- Clean frequently touched surfaces (phones, keyboards and tablets).
- Families who are seen by a medical professional should communicate with their school regarding their diagnosis.
- Students who test positive will be required to quarantine. Their siblings who are unable to isolate will also be quarantined.

We will maintain data on cases in our buildings and we receive community data each week from Weld County Health. As we monitor data, the restrictions and practices listed above may change.
