

## Asbestos Management

Highland conducted an extensive inspection and evaluation of asbestos containing materials in its buildings during spring and summer of 1988. The results of this work establishes the basis for our plans to control or remove asbestos from District buildings'. Our work also brought us into compliance with the Federal 1986 Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act.

The results of inspections and evaluation have been summarized in an asbestos management plan for the District. The plan is on file at each school building and at the Administration Building. You are welcome to review our asbestos management plan at any time during regular business hours.

The latest project involving asbestos containing materials took place during the summer of 2012. Flooring materials were removed from the cafeteria in Pierce. The Colorado Department of Health and Environment audited the District's asbestos program in September of 2012. Upcoming in November of 2012 a three year reinspection of all District facilities will take place.
