School Bus Rules and Contract

It is a privilege for a student to ride a Highland school bus. It is the responsibility of both the driver and student to do everything possible to make it a safe ride. The privilege of a student to ride a school bus is based on contingent observation of safety rules and acceptable behavior.

- 1. Only authorized passengers will be transported on school buses. Children will load and unload at their regular stop unless parental notification has been given to school personnel.
- 2. Students must be at the bus stop or approaching the stop in order for the driver to stop the bus.
- 3. Pupil Conduct as Bus Passengers:
 - The driver is in full charge of the bus and students. The driver has the right to assign seats t meet the needs of the majority of passengers. Students are responsible for the area in which they sit.
 - Unnecessary conversation with the driver is prohibited. Classroom noise level and behavior are the acceptable standards on a bus.
 - To prevent injury to students and others, do not stick objects, heads, or hands out of the bus windows or the driver may require you to keep windows closed.
 - Students are expected to be absolutely quiet at all Railroad crossings to allow the driver full concentration with this procedure.
 - No eating or drinking is allowed on the bus.
 - Possession of tobacco products, alcohol, or illegal drugs is not allowed on the bus and if found, district policies will be followed.
 - Students must sit in their seats facing forward. All aisles and stairwells must be kept clear at all times this includes students and/or objects. Students are not allowed to move around while the bus is in motion. This is required to prevent possible student injury.
 - Students must only use the front door to enter and exit the bus. Tampering with the emergency door and equipment is prohibited.
 - Aggressive behavior toward the driver or other passengers is unsafe and prohibited.
 - Possession of weapons such as knives, guns, chains or any other dangerous item that could inflict injury is strictly prohibited and illegal and if found district policies will be followed.
 - Glass Containers of any kind are not allowed. No animals or insects of any kind are allowed on the bus.
 - Throwing, spitting, kicking or shooting items inside the bus or out the windows is hazardous and prohibited.
 - Use of any flame or spark-producing device including, but not limited to: matches, lighters, etc. Are prohibited. The student will pay for any damage caused by the student to the bus.

I have read the bus rules and understand them. I know that if I choose not to follow these rules, I will be given a school bus discipline referral which if warranted may result in immediate suspension of riding privileges.

I understand that school administrators and transportation personnel are responsible to enforce consistent discipline policies throughout the district.
